### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to employees of the Department of Fire Services.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is 2 hereby amended by inserting in line 313, after the word "affairs" the following words:- , full time 3 employees of the department of fire services in the executive office of public safety and security, 4 provided they have previously been full time members of a fire department of any city, town, fire 5 district, Devens, the 104th Fighter Wing Fire Department or the Massachusetts Military 6 Reservation Fire Department, for ten years of more, and had previously been classified in group
