## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to Commonwealth employees taking public higher education courses .

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Active employees of the Commonwealth with over five years of state employment will be
- 2 allowed to take courses on a space available basis at any state college or public university with a
- 3 reduction in cost of fifty percent on tuition and fees.
