AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE RETIREMENT BOARD TO REINSTATE ANTHONY  
TAVERNA AS A MEMBER OF THE TEACHERS RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority  
of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter 32 of the General Laws or any other general or  
2 special law to the contrary, the teachers retirement board is hereby authorized and directed to reinstate as  
3 a member in the teachers retirement system Anthony Taverna, a former teacher in the Minuteman  
4 Regional Vocational Technical School District; provided, however, that said Anthony Taverna shall repay  
5 to said teachers retirement system for the purpose of establishing creditable service the amount of regular  
6 deductions together with regular interest from the period of service for which he waived his retirement  
7 allowance, such repayment to be made in one lump sum or in installments as the board shall prescribe.
