Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, members' years of
- 2 service in each group they are classified, as enumerated in paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of
- 3 section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, shall be averaged for the purposes of retirement,
- 4 including superannuation retirement.
