An Act relative to increasing retirement age.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Wherever, in any General Law, a retirement age of 55 is specified for Group 1 or
- 2 Group 2, it shall be taken to mean 60, and whenever, a retirement age of 45 is specified for
- 3 Group 4, it shall be taken to mean 50.
