*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           SECTION 1. Section 65D of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “offices” in line 72 the following
- 3   words:-
- 4           “regardless of whether his service in judicial office or offices was continuous.”
