An Act pertaining to retirement.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section three of Chapter32 of the General Laws as appearing in the Official Edition is  
2 amended by adding after the words “group 1” in line 279 the following; Uniformed employees of  
3 a municipal or public Emergency Medical Service who are certified at any level as an emergency  
4 medical technical by the Department of Public Health.
