An Act relative to certain licensed pipefitters and refrigeration technicians.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the clause “employees of the  
3 Massachusetts Port Authority who are employed as licensed electricians, utility technicians,  
4 steam engineers, watch engineers, boiler operators,” the following words:- “licensed pipefitters  
5 and refrigeration technicians.”
