# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year Two Thousand and Nine  
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## AN ACT RELATIVE TO ELIGIBILITY FOR STATE GROUP HEALTH INSURANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 2(e) of Chapter 32A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition,  
2 is amended in line 94 by inserting after the word “hours” the following:
- 3 or faculty who teach the equivalent of at least two three or more- credit courses per semester or four three  
4 or more- credit courses per calendar year at one of more state higher education institutions, including a  
5 division of continuing education, regardless of funding source, including but not limited to subsidiary  
6 account CC, and regardless of the term of employment
