An Act relative to local law enforcement continuity.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. A duly sworn officer of the Town of Dedham, who is authorized to exercise
- 2 police powers within said town, may exercise all such police powers within 500 yards into the
- 3 corporate limits of the City of Boston, as if such officer were a duly sworn officer of said city.
- 4 SECTION 2. A duly sworn officer of the City of Boston, who is authorized to exercise
- 5 police powers within said city, may exercise all such police powers within 500 yards into the
- 6 corporate limits of the Town of Dedham, as if such officer were a duly sworn officer of said
- 7 town.

- 8 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by the City of Boston, in the
- 9 manner provided by law and upon its acceptance in the Town of Dedham by a majority vote of
- 10 the board of selectmen.
