Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 330, after the word "affairs" the
- 3 following words:-, full time employees of the department of fire services in the executive office
- 4 of public safety and security, provided they have previously been full time members of a fire
- 5 department of any city, town, fire district, Devens, the 104th Fighter Wing Fire Department or
- 6 the Massachusetts Military Reservation Fire Department, for ten years of more, and had
- 7 previously been classified in group 4.
