Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by inserting the following section.
- 3 Section 2B. In addition to the foregoing tax there is hereby established an additional tax of \$5 on
- 4 the sale of tobacco rolling papers per package.
