3 SECTION 1. Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, in subsection 41A (2) is
4 hereby amended by striking out the words “the amount of income determined by the
5 commissioner of revenue for the purposes of subsection (k) of section 6 of chapter 62, for a
6 single person who is not a head of household” and inserting in place thereof the following
7 words:- “\$65,000”.
