AN ACT DIRECTING THE STATE RETIREMENT TO GRANT CREDITABLE SERVICE TO
DANIEL CONDON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority
of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the state
2 retirement board shall credit Daniel Condon with creditable service for the period of time between the year 1998 and
3 2002 inclusive, in which he was employed by the Congress of the United States for the purpose of determining his
4 superannuation retirement allowance pursuant to paragraph (a) of subdivision (2) of section 5 of chapter 32 of the
5 General Laws. Before the date that any retirement allowance becomes effective in the case of Daniel Condon, he
6 shall pay into the annuity savings fund of the state retirement system in one sum or installments, upon such terms
7 and conditions as the board may prescribe, an amount equal to that which would have been withheld as regular
8 deductions from his regular compensation for such previous service, plus interest.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
