Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any General or Special Law to the Contrary, Section 5K of Chapter 59
2 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended
3 in line 15, after the word “section”, the following:

4 “Such cities and towns shall also have the power to create local rules and procedures allowing
5 for persons over the age of 60 to volunteer to provide services in exchange for a reduction in
6 property tax obligations towards future tax years.”
