Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 35 of Chapter 91 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, after the last sentence of the first paragraph, the
- 3 following: -
- 4 Where sea level rise, storms, or other natural processes have caused the landward or lateral
- 5 movement of a barrier beach into an area which was previously occupied by the bottom of any
- 6 Great Pond or onto any other public land, the portion of the barrier beach relocated into the
- 7 former bottom of the Great pond or onto other public land shall be and remain in public
- 8 ownership.
