The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act promoting urban agriculture and horticulture.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, is
- 2 hereby amended by adding the following clause: -
- Fifty-ninth. Up to 100 percent of the assessed value of real estate in agricultural,
- 4 horticultural or agricultural and horticultural use, as those terms are defined in sections 1 and 2
- of chapter 61A, provided that the real estate or portion thereof in agricultural, horticultural or
- 6 agricultural and horticultural use is less than 2 acres in area; provided further, that gross sales of
- 7 agricultural, horticultural or agricultural and horticultural products resulting from such uses
- 8 together total not less than \$500 in the previous year. The exemption provided in this clause shall
- 9 apply only to the portion of real estate in agricultural, horticultural or agricultural and
- 10 horticultural use. This clause shall take effect in any city or town upon acceptance of this section;

- provided, that such city or town has a population of at least 50,000 inhabitants or meets the
- definition of a gateway municipality under section 3A of chapter 23A. The legislative body of
- any city or town that accepts this clause shall establish and may thereafter modify the percentage
- of the assessed value exempt from taxation.
