## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to pay parity for county correctional officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

- 1 SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the first year
- 2 base salary of a correctional officer employed by a sheriff's department shall be equal to not less
- 3 than ninety per cent of the first year base salary of a correctional officer employed by the
- 4 Massachusetts Department of Correction.
