In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to using capital gain income for one-time capital expenditures.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 29 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is

2 hereby amended by inserting the following new paragraph:-

3 2YYY. One-Time Capital Expenditures

4 There shall be established and set upon the books of the commonwealth a separate fund to be

5 known as the One-Time Capital Expenditure Fund to which shall be credited: (a) any funds that

6 shall be appropriated or transferred for deposit into the trust fund; and (b) any income derived

7 from investment of amounts credited to the trust fund (c) all Part C taxable income collected on

8 an annual basis by the Commissioner of Revenue pursuant to Section 2 (h) of Chapter 62, after

- 9 accounting for refunds, abatements or other adjustments. This money shall be expended for one-
- 10 time capital needs of the commonwealth as determined by the legislature and not for annual
- 11 operating expenses.
