An Act to ensure fairness in retirement benefits for certain employees of the department of corrections.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "assistant deputy
- 3 superintendent", in line 304, the following words:- "correctional program officer A/B, C, D or
- 4 equivalent or successive titles who have been employed in such capacities or other Group 4 titles
- 5 for 10 years or more;"
