**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court
(2023-2024)**

An Act to increase the working cap limit for municipal police retirees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 91 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 inserting after the word “year”, in line 98, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition, the
3 following words:- or, in the case of municipal police officers, for not more than 1,500 hours in
4 the aggregate, in any calendar year.

5 SECTION 2. Said section 91 of said chapter 32 is hereby further amended by inserting
6 after the word “aggregate”, in line 113, as so appearing, the following words:- , or 1,500, in the
7 aggregate, for municipal police officers.
