## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to the retirement system.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 105 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking subsections (b) and (c) and inserting the following new language:-
- 3 (b) A member shall be entitled to creditable service resulting from his reinstatement
- 4 service upon the completion of payments required under subsection (a) and payment of regular
- 5 deductions under section 22 for the reinstatement service. In the event that a retirement
- 6 allowance becomes effective for the member before the completion of payments under
- 7 subsection (a), the member shall be entitled to credit for that proportion of reinstatement service
- 8 as the board shall prescribe, in addition to any credit for service rendered prior to the date of
- 9 reinstatement, provided that the member would have otherwise been eligible for that prior
- 10 service.
