Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 3, the words "6.25 per cent" and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the following words:- 5 percent.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 30A of chapter 64H of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 5 amended by striking out, in lines 5, 7, 14 and 18, the figure "6.25" and inserting in place thereof,
- 6 in each instance, the following figure: 5.
- 7 SECTION 3. Section 2 of chapter 64I of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
- 8 amended by striking out, in line 6, the words "6.25 per cent" and inserting in place thereof the
- 9 following words:- 5 percent.
- SECTION 4. Section 31A of said chapter 64I, as so appearing, is hereby amended by
- striking out, in lines 5, 7, 14 and 18, the figure "6.25" and inserting in place thereof, in each
- 12 instance, the following figure: 5.
- SECTION 5. Sections 1 through section 4, inclusive, shall be effective January 1, 2014.
