#### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to protecting local retirees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 9E of chapter 32B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is amended by inserting at the end of the last sentence thereof the following new
- 3 sentence:- In the event that the governmental unit approves an increase in the percent of the
- 4 premium to be contributed by its retired employees, the percent of premium being paid by a
- 5 retired employee at that time will not be increased to the higher percent.
- 6 SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall take effect on January 1, 2022.
