An Act relating to the retirement of Charles Bletzer, an employee of the Trial Court of the Commonwealth.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding chapter 32 of the General Laws or any other general or  
2 special law to the contrary affecting the noncontributory or contributory retirement system in the  
3 commonwealth, the state board of retirement shall provide Charles Bletzer, an employee of the  
4 Trial Court who is permanently incapacitated from performing the essential duties of his  
5 position, a superannuation retirement allowance as provided by sections 5 and 10 of chapter 32,  
6 at the rate of eighty percent of his high three-year average salary.

7           SECTION 2. In the event that the said Charles Bletzer elects to retire under option B or  
8 option C of paragraph (2) of section 12 of chapter 32, said superannuation retirement allowance  
9 shall be reduced pursuant to said election.

10          SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
