Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Paragraph 1 of section 83 of chapter 169 of the acts of 2008 is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting in the first sentence, after the words "cost-effective long-term contracts" the following
- 3 new words:-
- 4 ", under which the cost of electricity shall be less than a 90% increase from the present average
- 5 market price of electricity measured in cents/kWh,".
- 6 SECTION 2. Paragraph 3 of section 83 of chapter 169 of the Acts of 2008 is hereby amended by
- 7 adding, after the words, "create additional employment in the commonwealth.", the following
- 8 new sentence:-
- 9 "The department of public utilities shall not approve a long-term contract in which the cost of
- 10 electricity under the contract is greater than a 90% increase from the present average market
- 11 price of electricity measured in cents/kWh.".
