## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act defining membership of retirement boards.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: Section 20 of sub-section (4) (b) of Chapter 32 is hereby amended by
- 2 deleting the third sentence in lines 205-209 of the 2014 Official Edition and inserting the
- 3 following: "If the fifth member is not chosen by the other four members within forty-five days
- 4 after the expiration or resignation of the term of the fifth member, said member shall be
- 5 appointed by the Public Employee Retire Administration Commission from a list of three names
- 6 , submitted by the remaining four members of the board; of individuals ready and willing to
- 7 serve, and the commission shall appoint the fifth member from such list.
