An Act relative to taxation abatements.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any General or Special Law to the contrary, Chapter 58, Section 8 of the  
2 General Laws, as appearing in the Official 2010 Edition, is hereby amended, by adding at the  
3 end of the section, the following:

4 "The Commissioner shall exercise his or her authority under this section to correct any  
5 assessment errors, regardless of the effects on taxes or charges."
