An Act to create the position of poet laureate for the commonwealth of Massachusetts..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 amended by adding, after section 5, the following new section:

3 Section 5A.

4 (a) The governor may select a poet laureate for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts from the  
5 list of nominees submitted to him or her by the Commonwealth Poet Laureate Nominating  
6 Committee pursuant to Section 5A (b) herein. The poet laureate shall be appointed to serve for a  
7 term of two years or until a successor is appointed and qualified as provided in this section.

8 (b) (1) There shall be a Poet Laureate Nominating Committee. The Poet Laureate Nominating  
9 Committee shall consist of five (5) members: one (1) member of the Senate, one (1) member of  
10 the House, one (1) member appointed by the Governor, and two (2) members of the Board of  
11 Directors of the Massachusetts Cultural Council. Poet Laureate Nominating Committee shall  
12 serve without compensation.

13 (2) The Poet Laureate Nominating Committee shall advertise for and receive nominations for the  
14 selection of the Poet Laureate for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The Poet Laureate  
15 Nominating Committee shall review all nominations and select a list of three (3) nominees who  
16 are residents of the Commonwealth, to submit to the Governor along with their biographical and  
17 professional information and supporting representative material and who, based on their poetic  
18 accomplishments, deserve recognition as the Poet Laureate for the Commonwealth. The  
19 Governor may select the Poet Laureate for the Commonwealth from the list of nominees for a  
20 two year term of office.

21 (c) In the event of a vacancy in the office of Poet Laureate for the Commonwealth, the vacancy  
22 shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment, and the person so appointed shall  
23 serve until a successor is appointed and qualified as provided in this section.

24 (d) The Poet Laureate for the Commonwealth during his or her term shall seek to raise the  
25 consciousness of all people, including, but not limited to school children to a greater appreciation  
26 of the reading and writing of poetry, and

27 (e) The poet laureate shall be an honorary position and the person appointed shall receive no  
28 remuneration. The person appointed to the position of poet laureate shall not be considered a  
29 state official or a state employee for such person's service in the position of poet laureate.
