Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 10 Section 35J of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out, in
- 2 line 6 the words "subject to appropriation by the General Court as follows:" and clauses (a)
- 3 through (e) and inserting in place thereof the following language:-
- 4 "applied to the Office of travel and tourism (Massachusetts Office of Travel and Tourism) as
- 5 follows:
- 6 (a) fifty percent of which shall be for financial assistance for the tourist promotion agencies
- 7 under section 14 of 23A
- 8 (b) notwithstanding the provisions of the preceding paragraphs or any other general or special
- 9 law to the contrary, for any fiscal year in which revenues deposited into the Massachusetts
- 10 Tourism Fund exceed the amounts deposited into said fund in the previous fiscal year, 50 percent

- 11 of the increase in said revenues shall be applied, subject to appropriation, to the Massachusetts
- 12 Cultural Facilities Fund, established pursuant to subsection (b) of section 42 of chapter 23G.
