Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 official
2 edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the word “section” in line 9 of paragraph one, the
3 following:— any new applicant shall have successfully completed ten (10) hours of drivers
4 education classroom instruction and ten (10) hours of road instruction by a certified driver’s
5 education school or association.
