Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1. Chapter 161A of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the

2 following section:-

3 Section 49. The authority shall make the services of The Ride available to persons residing in
4 any community within 25 miles of the city of Boston to transport them to the city of Boston for
5 medical related purposes.

6 The authority shall be reimbursed for the costs of providing such services by the commonwealth
7 health insurance connector board established by section 2 of chapter 176Q.
