Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "but not more than sixty months after the
- 3 effective date of such license." the following sentence: If an operator fails to renew their license,
- 4 they shall not receive any punishment for up to one year after their license's expiration date.
- 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is
- 6 hereby amended by inserting after Section 10A the following section-
- 7 Section 10B. If an operator's motor vehicle license has been expired for one year or less, it is to
- 8 still be considered valid, and they cannot receive punishment for driving with an invalid license.
