An Act relative to proper notification of license renewal.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Section 8 of Chapter 90
- 2 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding, at
- 3 the end of the section, the following words:
  
- 4 “The Registry of Motor Vehicles shall notify, via US Mail, all motor vehicle operators that their
- 5 license is due to expire, at minimum, 45 days prior to said expiration.”
