Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of Chapter 62 of the General Laws is hereby amended in the first
2 line of subsection (b) by striking “5.3 per cent” and replacing it with “five per cent”.
