An Act to promote cost savings through the use of public water.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 29 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2016 official edition is hereby  
2 amended by adding after section 71 the following section:-

3 Section 72. State funds shall not be used to purchase bottled water for use in facilities that  
4 are served by public water supplies or potable well water, except when required for safety, health  
5 or emergency situations.
