## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An act concerning charter school funding.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 89(ff) of Chapter 71 is hereby amended by striking the first sentence of the second
- 2 paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:
- In calculating the per pupil foundation budget component, the department shall calculate
- 4 a foundation budget for the students from each sending district attending the charter school in the
- 5 previous fiscal year, pursuant to the provisions of section 2 of Chapter 70; provided, that the
- 6 department shall not include in said calculation the assumed tuition-out special education
- 7 enrollment, nor any amounts generated by said assumed enrollment, as defined by said section 2;
- 8 provided further, that the calculation for assumed in-school special education enrollment
- 9 pursuant to said section 2 shall reflect the individual student full-time equivalent enrollment and
- 10 only the actual amounts generated by said enrollment in the previous fiscal year.
