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An Act relative to the use of project labor agreements.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 7 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official edition is  
2 amended by inserting the following new section:-

3           Section X. An awarding authority deciding to require a project labor agreement shall  
4 submit a report to the house and senate committees on ways and means outlining how the  
5 awarding authority concluded that said project labor agreement was legally justified within 60  
6 days of said decision.
