Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 15UUUU. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting aside the
- 2 month of May as the official month of kindness, recommending its observance by the people as a
- 3 period of special attention to the importance of being kind to each other with acts that will assist
- 4 those in need in a way that provides a path to self-sufficiency.
