**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court
(2015-2016)**

An Act declaring May as the official month of kindness.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 15UUUU. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting aside the
2 month of May as the official month of kindness, recommending its observance by the people as a
3 period of special attention to the importance of being kind to each other with acts that will assist
4 those in need in a way that provides a path to self-sufficiency.
