- 4 SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Boston
- 5 Metropolitan Area Planning Council shall conduct a study of potential flood storage locations
- 6 and water quality improvements in the Alewife Brook watershed in the Cities of Cambridge and
- 7 Somerville, and in the Towns of Arlington and Belmont.
- 8 Within one hundred and eighty (180) days of passage of this act, the Boston Metropolitan Area
- 9 Planning Council shall submit a report to the clerks of the House and Senate detailing a plan
- 10 concerning the implementation of said study.

- 11 SECTION 2: A sum of \$100,000 shall be appropriate for the purpose of funding the study
- 12 required by SECTION 1."
