An Act prohibiting the use of personal names on state property.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any rule or regulation, special or general law to the  
2 contrary, the placing of a personal name on any state property by an elected or appointed official  
3 of the Commonwealth shall be prohibited. Nothing in this section shall prohibit the naming of  
4 state property as part of a dedication in honoring individuals by the general court.
