Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 2 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

- 3 and Darci Hamann, as recorded by the third and fourth grade classes at Our Lady’s Academy in
- 4 Waltham shall be the official county song of the commonwealth.
