- 1 An Act changing the counting of affordable housing under Chapter 40B
- 2 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by
- 3 the authority of the same as follows:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 40B of the General Laws, is hereby amended by including as a category,
- 5 Section Eight Housing Vouchers in addition to already cited applicable affordable housing types.
