#### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to Massachusetts high school diplomas.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1. Section 1D of Chapter 69 of the Massachusetts General laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following paragraph after the
- 3 words "obtain a competency determination" in line 75:
- 4 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, no student who has met all
- 5 other requirements for a high school diploma, including passing grades in all required courses,
- 6 shall be denied a diploma because of a score on a state standardized test. This provision shall
- 7 apply for three school years following the effective date of this act.
