Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The twelve paragraph of section 113B of chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the sixth and seventh sentences and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the following 2 sentences:-
- 4 The registrar shall develop a system for separately reporting all non-moving violations. When the
- 5 registrar has implemented the system, all non-moving violations shall not be considered
- 6 surchargeable incidents.
