4 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 22E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 official  
5 edition, is hereby amended by striking the text thereof, and inserting in place thereof following: -

6 “Any person who is arrested by virtue of process, or is taken into custody by an officer and  
7 charged with the commission of a felony, and who upon arrest has been arraigned pursuant to the  
8 applicable court rules under the Massachusetts Rules of Criminal Procedure, shall submit a DNA  
9 sample to the department. The sample shall be collected by a person authorized under section 4  
10 of this chapter subsequent to arraignment, in accordance with regulations or procedures

11 established by the director. The results of such sample shall be made part of the state DNA  
12 database.

13 Section 2. Section 12 of chapter 22E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 official  
14 edition, is hereby amended in line 6 by striking out the words "\$1,000" and inserting in its place  
15 thereof the following words:- \$2,000. Said section is further amended in line 7 by striking out  
16 the words "six months" and inserting in place thereof the following words: - one year.

17 Section 3. Section 13 of chapter 22E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 official  
18 edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 4 the words "\$1,000" and inserting in its place  
19 thereof the following words:- \$2,000. Said section is further amended in line 5 by striking out  
20 the words "six months" and inserting in place thereof the following words: - one year.

21 Section 4. Section 15 of chapter 22E of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 official  
22 edition, is hereby amended in line 3 by adding after the word "expunged" the following: -

23 " if the original offense upon which the collection of DNA is based does not result in a  
24 conviction; or"
