An Act relative to Title 5 income tax credit reform.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 6(i) of Chapter 62 of the General Laws, as so appearing in the 2020  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in line 273 the figure “\$15,000” and inserting in  
3   place thereof the following:-- “\$25,000”; and, by striking in line 277 the figure “\$1,500” and  
4   inserting in place thereof the following:-- “\$4,000”; and by striking in line 279 the figure  
5   “\$6,000” and inserting in place thereof the following:-- “\$10,000.”
