Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 An Act relative to petition by city or town pursuant to home rule amendment.
- 3 SECTION 1. Chapter 3 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is
- 4 hereby amended by inserting after section 8A the following section:-
- 6 Section 8B. The approval vote required to file a petition pursuant to the provisions of
- 7 Section 8(1) of Article LXXXIX of the Amendments to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- 8 shall not expire, and no additional vote shall be required to file a petition unless a vote to rescind

- 9 such approval is passed by the voters of a city or town, or the mayor and city council or other
- 10 legislative body of a city, or the town meeting or other legislative body of a town.
