The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-Third General Court (2023-2024)

An Act establishing a fair share transparency and accountability fund.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020 Official Edition,

2 is hereby amended by adding after section 78 the following section:

3	Section 79. There shall be established and set up on the books of the commonwealth a
4	separate fund to be known as the Fair Share Transparency and Accountability Fund to be used
5	solely for education and transportation purposes. There shall be credited to the fund all revenues
6	collected pursuant to Article CXXI of the state constitution and any income derived from
7	investment of amounts credited to the fund. No monies deposited into this fund that are
8	unexpended at the end of the fiscal year shall revert to the General Fund. No expenditure from
9	said fund shall cause said fund to be in deficiency at the close of the fiscal year.
